From the Pastor



We have worshiped in some new ways in the last year. I had attended some Zoom meetings before the pandemic hit, but many of you had not. We traveled together well in the last year as we tried new technologies, as we overcame bumps, as musicians provided music from their homes, as we created a virtual choir

where people had the opportunity to sing together even though they were not in the same place, as we shared videos and as we are, now, broadcasting Sunday services using new equipment. And now, we are ready for our next step forward as a church: worshipping in-person and online together.

Many people in the Church are struggling to make sense of what the future holds. We have talked about our need to embrace change. We have talked about how the life of the Church has shifted and changed in cycles that come about 500 years apart. Leaders gathered for the Council of Nicaea in 325 CE (about 300 years after Jesus' death and resurrection) to resolve differences and write the Nicene Creed. The first Christian Crusade, which lasted three years, was launched in the year 1096 CE and was focused upon regaining possession of the Holy Land (about 700 years later). Martin Luther nailed his 95 Theses to the doors of the Castle Church in Wittenberg, Germany in 1517 CE (about 500 years after that) and the Protestant Reformation began. And now, 500 years still later, we find ourselves in the midst of dramatic shifts and changes.

You will be hearing us talk about the fact that Christ's Lutheran Church is now a "hybrid church." A "hybrid church" is a church where people can worship both online and in-person at the same time. A "hybrid church" is a church where people can join in a time of online fellowship at the end of a worship service while others receive Holy Communion. A "hybrid church" is a church that can still have a worship service when a snowstorm would require the building to be closed and is a church that has other events that only happen in-person. A "hybrid church" is a church where meetings can happen either online and in-person, where in-person Vacation Bible School and Sunday School continue, and where a Bible Study can be offered only online.

You can, surely, imagine that this is a bold step forward and an important opportunity for us to follow Jesus into the future. Here are some ways that you can help:

1. You can continue to offer your support and understanding. I have been touched by your encouraging cards and messages in the last year. The journey into this new and exciting territory has not been easy; and people, who have been standing on the front line, have offered a lot of their time and energy. Please know that we are all trying to do our best and that unexpected bumps in the road are still expected. Your continued support and encouraging words are deeply appreciated.
2. You can continue to read your newsletter, to visit CLC's Online Connect, to read email, to share our Facebook posts and to read announcements in the bulletin you receive when you join us for in-person worship. We want to remain connected and to share important information with you. You can help to make sharing important information a lot easier.
3. You can continue to attend worship and to financially support our ministry. The summer is quickly approaching, and many people are thinking about getting away for the first time in more than a year. Perhaps, you can worship with us online while you travel? You can, also, sign-up for automatic giving, so that it is easy to support our ministry while you are away. You can even mail your offering to the church before you leave home.
4. You can volunteer to help with a small task that needs to be done to make our in-person worship services possible. You can volunteer to unlock or to lock the doors. You can turn the lights on when you arrive or light candles. You can

greet people as they arrive and give them a bulletin. You can read a lesson. You can put the offering into the safe. You can extinguish the candles and return our Communion vessels to storage. You can even help to guide people during our celebration of Holy Communion or serve as a cohost who welcomes and helps people who are worshipping online.

5. You can offer your computer and technology skills. We cannot, realistically, broadcast our worship service each week with the help of only two or three people. We can teach you how to use our new camera equipment. You can help us to remain connected to people who are worshipping at home and to people who live thousands of miles away! And, in the process, you can learn new skills and develop new talents.
6. You can support our ministry by simply “going with the flow.” The Council is continuing to ask you to wear a mask when you are in the building (including during in-person worship), just as you are being asked to do so in many other places. Those who are leading worship are going to be wearing masks during in-person worship, which will make worshipping at home a little different. Please bear with us and know that we are doing our best to keep all who come to Christ’s Lutheran Church safe.

We are excited about moving forward and about discovering what being a “hybrid church” is going to be like. Please keep our church and all of our leaders in your prayer as we take this big step forward and continue to make disciples at Christ’s Lutheran Church.

- In person worship on April 25th was a success and we will continue to move forward with considering to reopen Saturday services in the near future.
