From the Pastor

Harvesting Resurrection

“Just as day was breaking, Jesus stood on the shore; yet the disciples did not know that it was Jesus. Jesus said to them, ‘Children, do you have any fish?’ They answered Him, ‘No.’ He said to them, ‘Cast the net on the right side of the boat, and you will find some.’ And so, they cast it, and now they were not able to haul it in, because of the quantity of fish.” ~ John 21:4-6

The days after Christ's death and resurrection were faith-altering. Everything had changed without notice. It was almost as if the disciples hadn't gotten the memo that announced that things that they had depended upon were going to fall apart and be born anew. And yet, that's what happened in the short verses that I've quoted above.

Our journey through the pandemic has been faith-altering, too. We've made it through the days when we were not able to gather in-person for worship. We've made it through the days when people got tired of worshipping on Zoom and drifted away from the Church – although the size of our congregation changed in the process. We've pulled together and, with the help of a \$30,000 PPP loan that we didn't need to repay,

financially survived a time when many congregations folded. And now, we're standing together on a new shore and at the edge of a new frontier. Thankfully, we are not in a place that's unknown to God's people. Imagine the day when the Risen Christ asked the disciples how many fish they had caught and they responded, "None," and when Jesus commanded them to drop their nets again. Imagine the Israelites gazing across the Sea that had just swallowed up the army that had been pursuing them and realizing that they needed to follow God into a land of promise and new beginnings.

We are in the exact same spot. The coronavirus catapulted us five years into a future that we were already trying to imagine. Our remaining debt is limiting our church's mission, is driving a nearly crippling deficit, and is forcing us to withdraw funds we could use for other things in order to pay our monthly bills. We are operating the church with a dangerously short front line of volunteers partly because more than half of the faithful people who join us in worship each week still worship at home. It's easy to see some empty nets. It's easy to become frightened as we realize that the Church of 2019 is not coming back, and that the future of the Church is going to be discovered by those who follow God into a new land. Death and resurrection are never easy. The Exodus was faith-altering.

Many big things are going to happen in October. I'm excited to see children starting to fill our Sunday School classes again and I'm looking forward to celebrating First Communion with some of our young people. I'm inviting you to join me in a time of learning and sharing as we discuss what's happening in the Post-Pandemic Church and as I invite you to share your thoughts and perspectives with me, with our Council, and with each other. I hope to see you at our upcoming movie night. I, also, look forward to our celebration of Harvest Home as an opportunity to celebrate what God is doing in our midst and to invite you to think about what God may be calling you to do during this critical time.

Harvesting Resurrection is what I believe Christ is inviting us to do right now. We continue to baptize little babies and to welcome new partners in ministry. We continue to embrace new ways to use the wonder of technology to build up the Body of Christ. We know that Jesus is working in your life right now and that you are discovering God-given hopes and

dreams for your life and for our congregation in your times of prayer. We continue to cast nets into the sea at Christ's command and continue to gaze toward the future that God is creating with hope trusting that God is going to provide what we need in order to continue the life-giving ministry of Christ's Lutheran Church for many years to come.

October is a great month to harvest resurrection! New life is all around us! God is opening new doors to a bright and exciting future! Thanks be to God!

Dear friends, one of the amazing opportunities we've had coming out of the pandemic has been our ability to reach so many more people with the new technology capabilities that we have. Indeed, the technology has allowed our church to grow and function through one of the toughest times in history. As we have gone through this process of updating our computers and software and cameras, we have found that our infrastructure needs support. We want to continue our ministry here at Christ's Lutheran Church by continuing support the livestream services, and updating our Church Management Software.

As most of you know, the building itself has also had some issues that we have had to address over the last couple of years. From a major project with the storm water drain in the parking lot, termites infesting our attic, and several other building maintenance issues, this hasn't been an easy time for us to go through.

Last week, the council sent out a letter to the congregation explaining some of these situations we have gone through and the state of the church with our finances. We are humbly asking you to please review that letter, and try to come to a better understanding of what we are going through as a church community. Our finances are stretched pretty thin right now and we are going to need your support.
